

Selectmen Meeting Minutes
May 28, 2019

Raymond Gorman called the meeting to order at 12: 05. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Tammy Letson spoke to the Board about proceeding with the warrant for the first issue of property taxes even though the data merger was not completely reconciled. Sue mentioned that the date on the cover sheet should be updated before signatures were rendered.

Motion: Sue Collins made a motion to approve the issuance of the first billing of property taxes with a clerical correction to the document date. Ray Gorman seconded. All in favor.

Melanie Mathieu informed the Board that taxes were taken out of BOS stipends and the check issued represent the net amount.

Melanie also brought the Board up to speed on the status of the Stone Garden police contract reimbursement process.

Mike Furbush of Sign Shop North had a discussion with the Board and town manager on the design and content of the new Town of Colebrook sign for town hall. Content, color and sign materials were discussed and Mike will get back to the town manager with sketches and quotes for various designs soon.

A letter of support for reopening ATV road crossings was discussed. The Board directed the town manager to draft a letter to NHDOT Commissioner Sheehan and related agencies.

Motion: Sue Collins made a motion to draft a letter of support for ATV road crossing openings. Ray Gorman seconded. All in favor.

Motion: Sue Collins made a motion to adjourn. Ray Gorman seconded. The meeting adjourned at 1:10 pm.
