

Colebrook Selectboard Meeting

March 12, 2021

12:30pm

Town of Colebrook, Town Hall – Conference Room

Selectmen Members Present: Sue Collins, Selectman; Ray Gorman, Acting Chairperson.

Staff Present: Sharon Penney, Town Manager; Christine Charman; Assistant to the Town Manager.

Guests: Greg Placy, Jenny Mitchell, Blue Bags Program Coordinator. Joining later: Donna Jordan, Colebrook Chronicle; Jake Mardin, News & Sentinel; David Collins, Citizen of the Year 2021.

Acting Chairman Ray Gorman, called the meeting to order at 12:40pm.

Ray Gorman made a motion to approve Greg Placy's appointment to the Colebrook Select Board. Sue Collins seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Deb Thompson, Assistant Town Clerk, administered the Oath of Office for Greg to fill a vacancy on the Board from March 9, 2021 to March 8, 2022.

Request to meet with the Board. Jenny Mitchell presented her plans for a community clean-up which she would like to schedule for May 15, 2021, with a back-up date of May 1, 2021.

She has spoken to Danny Lynch who has helped in the past and is willing to pick up the blue bags of trash at two designated areas on the community clean-up day.

Ray encouraged Jenny to speak with Melissa Shaw, who has coordinated a clean-up day in the past. In addition, he encouraged Jenny to speak with the Hasselbachers who have been involved as well.

Jenny said she would get in touch with these people and that she had been in touch with the SAU superintendent as well. She has included the Key Club, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts on her contact list.

Sharon signed the form as the Town of Colebrook Representative. Jenny is the primary contact for this year's program.

Jenny had a question for the board about an apparent dump site on private property on South Main Street.

There was no further discussion.


Sue Collins made a motion to elect Greg Placy as chairperson of the select board for the next year. Ray Gorman seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
