

We have examined, audited and allowed the selectmen's bills, have compared the order books of the selectmen with the accounts of the treasurer and find that they compared with each other and are correctly computed.

It will be seen by the town report that the expenditures for the past year have exceeded the appropriations, fourteen hundred sixty-five dollars and thirty-one cents. This was occasioned by various causes, one of which was the sum of \$579.50, which was the cost of the new road east of the A. J. Hibbard place, which was laid out on a petition signed by nearly half the voters in town.

No money was raised last year for school books and supplies and there has been expended for that purpose the sum of \$358.03 and the sum of \$510.08 in concreting side-walks. Whereon concrete has been laid, the adjoining owners have paid half the expense. The crossings at corner of Main and Parsons Sts., Main and Bridge Sts. and that at the Methodist Church were all put in by subscription and not at the expense of the town. The three items above mentioned amount to \$1447.61 substantially the amount which the town was run behind during the year.
