Warrant

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Colebrook, in the County of Coos, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Town of Colebrook, on Tuesday, the 11th day of March next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose by ballot and major vote a Town Clerk for the year next ensuing.
- 2. To choose by ballot and major vote one Selectman for the next three years ensuing.
- 3. To choose by ballot and major vote, a Trustee of Trust Funds for the three years next ensuing.
- 4. To choose by ballot and major vote a Library Trustee for the three years next ensuing.
- 5. To choose by ballot and major vote one or more Highway Agents for the year next ensuing.
- 6. To choose by ballot and major vote a Tax Collector for the year next ensuing.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to elect by major vote one or more Police Officers, to serve the town for the year ensuing.
- 8. To choose by ballot and major vote one or more Auditor for the year next ensuing.

- 9. To see if the Town will instruct its Selectmen to appoint all other Town Officers as required by law.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to approve Town Charges as shown by the Budget and raise money for the payment of same.
- 11. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Poor.
- 12. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Town Library.
- 13. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the construction of Highways and Bridges:
 - (a) To see if the town will vote the sum of \$2252.00 for the completion of the Bungy Road from the East Side road to the Columbia town line, provided that the State will appropriate the sum of \$2252.00 for the same purpose, it being understood that if said appropriation is made by the State and the Town accepts special aid that the Town shall not be entitled to State Aid for Class II roads.
 - (b) To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$714.94 for the T. R. A. construction provided the State will contribute the sum of \$2859.75 for the same purpose and the joint sum to be expended on roads which are designated by the State as T. R. A. roads.
 - (c) To see what sums of money the Town will raise and appropriate for summer and winter maintenance of Town Roads.
 - (d) To see what sum of money the Town will raise and appropriate for the purchase of snow fence.

- (e) To see if the Town will vote to instruct, authorize, and empower its Selectmen to purchase to suitable Town Truck, provided the Selectmen deem it necessary and conducive to the best interest of the Town; and to use money from the general fund not otherwise appropriated, in payment of the same.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate and raise the sum of \$1000.00 to be used by Road Agents and Selectmen for hiring special equipment to assist in the building and plowing of T. R. A. Roads.
- 15. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for:(a) Sewer Maintenance and Construction.
- 16. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the observance of Memorial and Armistice Days and the care of monument lots.
- 17. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the care of Cemeteries.
- 18. To see what sums of money the Town will vote to raise towards the maintenance of a free skating rink.
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.-00) for the rent of premises known as the ball ground, to be used as a baseball field for the High School, and for any other athletic games by any organization of and in the Town.
- 20. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for tarring streets.
- To see what sums of money the Town will vote to raise for the construction and repair of Sidewalks.

- 22. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for Police.
- 23. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of Town Hall to Public Schools in said Town, for school purposes, including heat, light, and janitor service, whenever such use does not conflict with the best interests of the Town, for the year next ensuing.
- 24. To see if the Town will vote to authorize its Selectmen to borrow money to defray expenses of the Town in anticipation of taxes, for the year next ensuing.
- 25. To see if the Town will vote to authorize its Selectmen to sell at public auction to such purchasers and for such price as they may determine, any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collector's deeds, and until such sale is made to administer such property in the interests of the town.
- 26. To see what sum of money, if any, the Town will vote to raise to issue and distribute, or contribute toward the issuance and distribution through other agencies of circulars and other written or printed matter calling attention to the resources and natural advantages of the Town.
- 27. To see what amount, if any, the Town will vote to raise for the purpose of defraying expense of trimming shade and ornamental trees within the limits of the Highway in said Town of Colebrook, for the year ensuing.
- 28. To see if the Town will vote to instruct, authorize and empower the Selectmen of said Town to purchase a new Town Clock with proper striking facilities, to replace the old Town Clock now located in the belfry of the Congregational Church, and make appropriation for the same.

- 29. To see if the Town will vote to instruct, authorize and empower its Selectmen to repair the present Town Clock now located in the belfrey of the Congregational Church so that it will keep accurate time and strike audibly each and every hour, and make appropriations for same.
- 30. To see if the Town will vote to accept, ratify and confirm the reports of Agents, Selectmen, Auditors, Committees and all other Town Officers as contained in the annual report of said Town for the year January 31, 1941,A. D.
- 31. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the highway leading from the turn on the Frank Keazer (Barney Carr) farm in a northwesterly direction to the John Haney road so-called.
- 32. To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting.

REPORT OF HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The year of 1940 was very free from contagious and infectious diseases until the very last month, when a moderately severe epidemic of whooping cough was contracted, which is still prevailing, although the symptoms are gradually abating. Miss Varney has kept up a constant vigil, excluding pupils on the appearance of symptons of the malady, which has somewhat lessened the exposures but which has been of more value to the victims of the disease that they might receive treatment before it became too far advanced.

There has been a mild type of influenza, which has attacked all ages, usually entire families but recovery has occurred after a few days except in a small number of elderly people who apparently contacted a more virulent type of the disease.

No other contagious diseases have been in the community, except a few cases of chicken pox which as usual were very mild.

The water and milk supply have been examined at different times during the year and have been found satisfactory on all occasions.

A great deal of credit is due Miss Varney for her untiring efforts in the schools, her excellent co-operation with the teachers, and the interest she has taken in the homes of families when their children were confined with illness, also for her promptness in notifying the health department at the outbreak of any communicable disease.
