

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Warrant

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Colebrook, in the County of Coos, in the State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in town affairs:—

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Town of Colebrook on Tuesday, the 13th of March, next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To bring in your ballots for the election of Town Officers to be elected by ballot for the Town of Colebrook for the ensuing year.
2. To act upon all other following articles contained in this Warrant
3. To see if the Town will instruct its Selectmen to appoint all other Town Officers as required by law
4. To see if the Town will vote to approve Town Charges as shown by the Budget and raise money for the payment of same
5. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Poor for the ensuing year
6. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for Old Age Assistance for the ensuing year
7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for support of the Town Library for the ensuing year

8. To see if the Town will approve the purchase of a new furnace for the Library and to raise the money necessary for the same.
9. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the maintenance of summer and winter roads, for the ensuing year.
10. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the General Expenses of the Highway Department for the ensuing year.
11. To see if the Town will raise the sum of \$744.52 for maintenance, construction or reconstruction of Class V highways in which event the State will contribute \$4,963.44.
12. To see what sum of money the Town will appropriate for tarring streets for the ensuing year
13. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to use as much as may be required of the proceeds received from parking meters, to pay such appropriation as may be voted under Article 12.
14. To see if the Town will vote to remove the snow from the business area of the villiage, defining the area to be cleared, and to raise money for the same.
15. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for plowing and sanding sidewalks, for the ensuing year.
16. To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$1,500.00 for the construction of sidewalks in accordance with the vote taken at the 1952 Town Meeting, for the ensuing year.
17. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for sewer maintenance, for the year ensuing

- 18 . To see if the Town will vote to maintain a free skating rink for the ensuing year, and to raise the money necessary for same.
- 19 . To see if the Town will vote to reconstruct the Kidderville Hill and Diamond Pond Roads and to raise the sum of \$3,000 for this purpose, in which event the State will contribute \$6,000 toward this work.
- 20 . To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to purchase a new site for a town dump, and to improve it as is necessary. and
- 21 . In the event Article 20 is not approved, to see if the Town will vote to continue the present dump location, and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 to buy an additional parcel of land adjoining same.
to appropriate money for the same.
- 22 . To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Police for the ensuing year.
- 23 . To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for care of Cemeteries for the ensuing year.
- 24 . To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Civilian Defense for the ensuing year.
- 25 . To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$300 for the observance of Memorial Day and the care of the Monument Lot.
- 26 . To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$1,500 for hydrant rental for the ensuing year
- 27 . To see if the provision of Chapter 171-A of the Revised Laws relative to playing Beano, shall be adopted in Colebrook.

28. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of the Town Hall to public Schools in said Town for school purposes including heat, light and janitor services, whenever same does not conflict with the best interests of the Town, for the year ensuing.
29. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate to the Colebrook and North Country Chamber of Commerce, for the purpose of publicizing and promoting, by advertising folders and otherwise, the Town and the North Country Region.
30. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$262.41 to the White Mts. Region Association, being 10 cents per \$1,000 of the assessed valuation, for the purpose of issuing and distributing printed matter and advertising and otherwise publicizing the advantages of the Town, in cooperation with the other 45 towns in the region.
31. To see if the Town will vote to make a contribution to the New Hampshire Marine Memorial being erected at Hampton Beach, and if so to make an appropriation for the same.
32. To see if the town will vote to adopt a plan for extending to employees of the town the benefits of title II of the Federal Social Security Act (Old Age and Survivor's Insurance) as authorized by Chapter 101 of the Revised Statutes Annotated, as amended by Chapters 301 and 332 of the Laws of 1955, and to raise and appropriate such sums as may be necessary to defray the town's share of the cost thereof.
33. To see if the Town wishes to exclude from the above plan, services in any class or classes of positions filled by popular election.

34. To see if the Town wishes to exclude from the plan, services in any class or classes of positions the compensation for which is on a fee basis
35. If a plan for Social Security coverage is adopted, to see if the Town will authorize the selectmen to execute on behalf of the town the necessary agreement with the State of New Hampshire to carry into effect the plan and to see if the town will designate the Selectmen as officers responsible for administration of the plan.
36. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$300 for payment of rent of the Parking Lot for the year ensuing.
37. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money to defray the expenses of the Town in anticipation of taxes for the year ensuing.
38. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell at public auction any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collectors' deeds, and until the sale is made, to administer such property in the best interests of the Town.
39. To see if the Town will vote to accept, ratify and confirm the reports of Agents, Selectmen, Auditors and all other Town Officers as contained in the Annual Report of said Town for the year ending December 31, 1955.
40. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a Zoning Commission of five members to recommend to the next Town Meeting, or any special Town Meeting which may be legally convened before the next Annual Town Meeting, the boundaries of zoning districts and appropriate regulations to be en-

forced therein in accordance with sections 31:60 to 31:89 inclusive, New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, the Zoning Commission to make a preliminary report and hold public hearings thereon before submitting its final report to Town Meeting for action.

41. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

During the year I have issued 959 1955 Motor Vehicle Permits amounting to \$8550.84, and 34 1956 Permits amounting to \$575.00. Both these sums were paid to the Town Treasurer.

I was also paid \$10.00 for a Circus Permit to Beeres and Barnes Circus, and have received \$104.50 from parking fines.
